DEAN'S BIOGRAPHY

Gregory D. Abowd

Dean of the College of Engineering Professor of Electrical and Computer Engineering Affiliated Professor, Khoury College of Computer Sciences, and Bouvé College of Health Sciences

Dean Gregory D. Abowd is an internationally renowned and highly cited scientist for his contributions in the general area of Human-Computer Interaction, and specifically for his groundbreaking research in ubiquitous computing. He is a Member of the American Academy of Arts and Scientists, Fellow of the Association for Computing Machinery, member of the prestigious ACM CHI Academy, and recipient of the ACM Eugene Lawler Humanitarian Award for his work in autism and technology, the ACM SIGCHI Lifetime Achievement Award for Research, and the ACM SIGCHI Special Recognition Award. Abowd is principal investigator of the National Science Foundation's Engineering PLUS Alliance—the only NSF INCLUDES Alliance for engineering. He also initiated a neurodiversity support program with industry and academic partners. He holds an M.Sc. and D.Phil. from the University of Oxford in Computation where he attended as a Rhodes Scholar.
